From the Minister's Desk

If you've attended in-person Sunday services this year, you'll know that we've been complying with the Covid contact tracing requirements at the doors to the church – sometimes it causes a traffic jam! We've also been wearing name tag stickers – because the value of knowing and being known outweighs the nuisance of putting on a name badge :)

This Sunday, we're changing the system to try and make things simpler. On arrival you will be given a plastic name badge and a paper insert. One side of the paper has a space for your name and on the other, your basic contact details (this is the last form we will ask you to fill in, promise!) Fold the paper and slip it into the plastic holder - that will be your nametag for the day. After the service, drop the badge into the box at one of the exits and we will generate a contact tracing list based on which nametags were used. Then, from next Sunday, there will be no more writing labels, or checking names on lists - a printed label will be ready for you to pick up on arrival and hand in after the service - simple :)

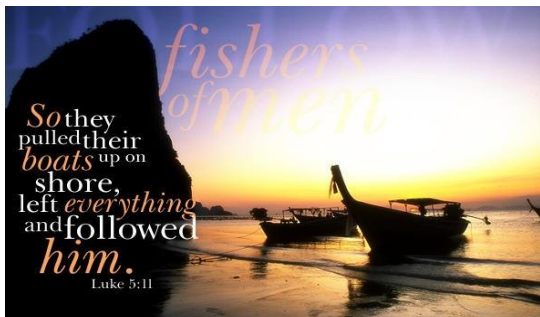
